PUP Default Plans

Default student dismissal plans need to be updated by Wednesday September 15th. This means that parents need to log in to PUP and submit a default plan for a full week. Even if the default plan hasn't changed from last year, please delete and re-enter the plan so it will update with a current date.

In the web app, the default plan tool is represented by the bus icon. This should not be used for a plan change affecting only one day. Teachers will not see that on their notifications.

The daily plan change tool is represented by the calendar icon. When a dismissal plan changes, parents should only be submitting a change for that day, not a default plan change. Teachers do see this on their notifications.

The Weare Bus Company has asked for the following information to be included with any default plans or daily plan changes:

- If a student rides more than one bus a day as their default plan, (an AM bus and a PM bus), please specify in the notes which bus is which.
- If a plan change requires a student to go home with another student, please specify that student's name or an address.
- All default plans should have either the student's address or the bus stop number.

Parent Pick-up and Drop-off

Please remember, students may not be dropped off in the morning before **7:10**, and all students should be in school by **7:25** to be ready to start instructional time at 7:30. At 7:30, students are considered tardy and will need to sign in at the office before heading to their class.

Students may only exit vehicles once the cars are fully in the drop-off lane in front of the building. As cars enter the drop-off lane, please pull as far forward as directed by staff.

Covid Information:

Families will now be notified by email if their child experienced a potential exposure to a positive case in our building. That notification will include recommendations for families from the NH Department of Health and Human Services. You will receive a second notification if your child was determined to be a close contact due to classroom seating or small group work. We will use the information in Pickup Patrol to identify potential exposure on buses so please keep this information as current as possible. If your child rides two different buses on the same day regularly (ie. takes the bus to Strong Beginnings afterschool) please specify the AM and PM Bus in the notes section in PUP.

McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Act

All school-aged children have the right to attend school no matter their housing status. The McKinney-Vento Act was established to assist children who may be experiencing home insecurity. The McKinney-Vento Act addresses the needs of students and families

who lack "a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence" which includes children and families who live in the following situations:

- · In a shelter, motel, vehicle or campground
- Doubled up with friends or relatives because you cannot find or afford housing
- · On the street, or
- · In an abandoned building, trailer, or other inadequate accommodations.

Everyone appeared to put forth their best effort and maintain a good attitude during the testing, and we now have one more data point to consider when looking at a student's profile. The iReady assessments are an important tool, not only for the special education department but for all teachers, to help monitor student growth throughout the year and to help pinpoint which instructional areas in which our students might need additional instruction. By gaining a deeper knowledge of our students' needs, our educators are able to tailor their instruction to address any skill gaps that have been identified. This means that not only are we collecting data on our students' skills, we are able to transform that data into meaningful insights that drive our interventions and instruction. We appreciate our students working hard on this assessment and look forward to putting all of this information to good use in the year to come.
